IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND SOME OF OUR RULES

The Texas Tree Climbing Championship is a lot of fun, but in order for the day to go smoothly and safely, it is really important that everyone agrees to follow the rules. These are just a few:

First: Please fill out the front of this form legibly.

The competition takes place on Friday, May 29th and 30th. You must attend the mandatory meeting Friday, May 29th at 10:30am in the event park. If you are not present for roll call, unless you have called head judge Nevic Donnelly (512-922-7058) in advance with a valid reason (death, divorce, dismemberment) you will be disqualified and your entry fee forfeited. You must bring with you all gear you intend to use, as this meeting will be for inspecting all gear, as well as reviewing the events.

You will have until the start of the competition (12:30pm, May 29th, Friday) to replace any disallowed equipment. All equipment for life support must be rated to a minimum of 5,000 lbs. Sharing equipment is allowed, but not recommended.

Rules of the competition will follow the International Tree Climbing Championship rules published by ISA as closely as local restrains allow. They are available online at www.isa-arbor.com. It is the contestant's responsibility for his or her own safety to know the rules. You will be allowed to ask questions about rules at the mandatory meeting, but time will be limited, and it is strongly recommended that you keep questions to things not plainly addressed in the ITCC rule book. If you cannot access these rules online, call Nevic at least three weeks before the competition.

Time is critical to a well run competition. If you are not present for roll call on the afternoon of the competition you will be disqualified and your entry fee forfeited. If you are not present when your name is called at any individual event you will be disqualified from that event.

Anyone can enter the Texas TCC, but since the winner of the competition will represent the Texas Chapter at the International Tree Climbing Championship, only Texas residents can be declared winner. Those who live out of state can compete, but not in the Masters Challenge, which determines the winner. Their scores will be held aside. Females: unless we have three or more female competitors registered one month before the competition, all events will be identical for male and female contestants. Highest placing female may represent Texas chapter at International, but unless there are three or more female contestants, (or she is highest placing of all contestants) the chapter may not pay her expenses.

The winner shall have his airfare and hotel paid for to attend the 2009 ITCC as our chapter representative. If he cannot make it, then the second place finisher will go as our chapter representative. You must be a member of ISA (not just a chapter) to compete at International. Be aware that our chapter rules may be slightly different from those of International
